



Free Trash Day

BuRRT and Caja del Rio Landfill

Saturday, September 19

The Santa Fe Solid Waste Management Agency is hosting Free Trash Day for **City of Santa Fe and Santa Fe County residents** on Saturday, September 19, from 8 a.m. to 4:45 p.m. at the Buckman Road Recycling and Transfer Station (BuRRT) and Caja del Rio Landfill.

The Agency anticipates a large turnout for this popular event, so be prepared for a longer wait time. Residents needing assistance with unloading should bring help with them. Residents must also observe the following:

- Limit to one load.
- All loads must be secured and covered with a tarp.
- All vehicles with trailers must go to the landfill.
- All non-acceptable items will be subject to tipping fees.
- No commercial or business waste will be accepted.
- Loads that arrive in commercial vehicles or trailers will be assumed to be commercial-business waste and will be subject to tipping fees.

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, all customers must:

- **Wear a facemask or face-covering at all times.**
- **Limit to two people per vehicle.**
- **Stay within their parking space and keep six feet away from others.**

Acceptable items:

Garbage, rubbish, unwanted materials
Bulky items – appliances, furniture, mattresses
Residential building materials, carpet, tiles, concrete, bricks, metals

Non-acceptable items:

Electronic Waste – Free E-Waste Day is October 3.
Household Hazardous Waste – Free HHW Day is November 7.
Tires – Free Tire Days are the first full weekend of every month.
Green Waste – Free Green Waste Days are the first full weekend of March, April, May and June.

The Santa Fe County's convenience centers are **not** part of the free trash day. Residents will be charged the appropriate punches on their punch card.

The Agency encourages recycling and repurposing of all items possible.
