The Santa Fe Solid Waste Management Agency is looking for all old electronic items (e-waste) that Santa Fe City and County Residents no longer want! The Agency will take these items off your hands for **FREE** and recycle them properly on **Saturday, October 2, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.** at the Buckman Road Recycling & Transfer Station (BuRRT) at 2600 Buckman Road. This is a drive-thru event that allows you stay in your vehicle while trained staff unloads the e-waste from your trunk or pickup bed.

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, all residents must:

- **Wear a mask or face covering.**
- **Stay inside their vehicle.**
- **Place their e-waste in the car trunk/SUV cargo area/ pickup bed for trained staff to unload it.**
- **Limit to one trip.**



What is E-Waste?

E-waste is electronic equipment that is near or at the end of its useful life. Certain components of e-waste contain toxic materials such as lead, mercury and cadmium.

Acceptable E-Waste includes:

- Computers, keyboards, mice, cables
- Monitors, televisions, cords
- Laptops, printers, scanners
- Telephones, cell phones, tablets, cameras
- Gaming systems and stereo equipment
- Small appliances, microwaves, toasters

Do not bring:

- Rear-projection televisions
- Large CRT televisions
- Batteries
- Lightbulbs, fluorescent bulbs
- Smoke alarms
- Large household appliances
- Household hazardous waste

What if I can't make it to the event?

Residents can take their E-Waste to BuRRT any day of the week during normal operating hours. The minimum cost is \$6.00 which covers up to 240 lbs. Televisions and computer monitors are \$10.00/unit.
